Dear Parent/Carer

RE: School Uniform

We are aware that many of you will be thinking about buying school uniform for the new school year. We have had several queries from parents/carers about what is acceptable so would like to confirm that:

- Pupils do not have to wear the coat with the school badge if they do not want to, but coats must be plain black with no visible logo.
- Hoodies are NOT acceptable. Jumpers should be plain black with a V-neck.
- Jeans and leggings are NOT acceptable.

Shoes

We have seen a rising number of pupils wearing trainers instead of school shoes. Trainers are NOT acceptable, even if they are plain black so please do not buy any for your child to wear to school.

Shoes must be leather or pleather and plain black. Mesh, canvas or other types of fabric are not appropriate for school shoes. There are pictures on the other side of this letter to help clarify it further.

We have high expectations of our pupils not only with regard to attendance and behaviour, but also with regard to their uniform. The way our pupils dress reflects on West Monmouth School within the community.
