Why mixed ability?

We believe that all pupils benefit from a fresh start when they commence secondary school. Therefore, all pupils are placed in mixed ability classes for Year 7. Instead of setting, teachers will differentiate work to ensure that pupils of all abilities within classes are challenged appropriately. From Year 8, pupils are placed in sets for core subjects.



All schools have a statutory responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of their pupils by:

The Safeguarding Policy is available on the school's website and a paper copy is available from school, on request.


Your first day at WMS:

West Mon Wednesday


West Mon Wednesdays is a new initiative for Year 7 pupils in West Monmouth School.
